**Objective:** Above and Beyond Permanent Debt Reduction (PDR) - Striving to reduce debt as we continue the Walk of Faith for the building of God’s Kingdom through faithful commitments.

We want to leave a legacy for our children and our children’s children for they are the future generations of FBCB. The Word says in Proverbs 13:22a, “A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children.” (KJV)

Above and Beyond will no longer have continuing phases. The Live by Faith PDR Capital Campaign is **on-going**. We ask that you be **prayerful**, make a monthly **commitment** and be **constant** in your giving above your tithe and offering.

As of 1/17/2010 we have 1,837 FBCB members. If we ALL make a monthly commitment, our ministry efforts can be boundless. Following are examples of the monthly and yearly contributions based on 500 and/or 1000 members’ monthly contributions:

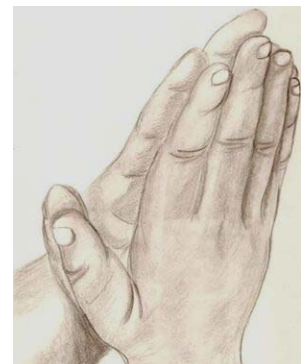

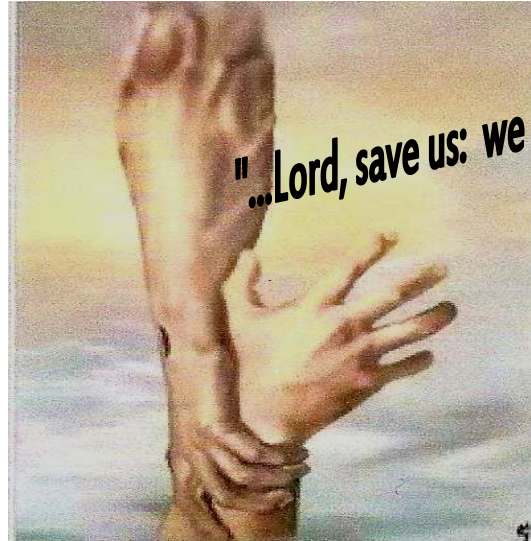

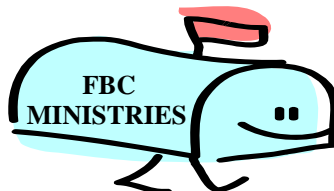
